NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE GARFIELD CLEAN ENERGY COLLABORATIVE, THAT:

- The Amended Budget and Supplemental Appropriation as submitted and summarized by fund, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, hereby is approved and adopted for the calendar year 2012.
- That the Amended Budget and Supplemental Appropriation hereby approved and adopted shall be signed by the Authority, made a part of the public records of the Authority and submitted to the Colorado Division of Local Government.
