



Sustainability Program 2023 Rebates

WATER EFFICIENCY REBATES

Fixture Replacement Rebates

Rebates are for qualifying high-efficiency products (see separate program guidelines).

Clothes washer	\$50
Dishwasher	\$50
High-efficiency hot water heater	\$100
Insta-Hot hot water delivery system	\$100
Sink faucet	\$35 (max 3 per year)
Showerhead	\$50 (max 2 per year)
Toilet	\$50 (max 2 per year)

Sprinkler System Equipment Rebates

Rain sensor	50% up to \$15 (wired) or \$30 (wireless)
Soil moisture sensor	50% up to \$45
Controller	\$50
Weather station add-on	50% up to \$40
Flow sensors	50% up to \$100
Spigot timers	50% up to \$50
Rotary nozzles	\$3 each (min 5 units, max 24 units)
Drip irrigation conversion equipment	50% up to \$100

Irrigation Audit Rebates

Audit must be performed by a certified professional.

Residential	\$75 (max 1 per 3 calendar years)
Commercial/multifamily/HOA/Irrigation	\$125 (max 1 per 3 calendar years)

Irrigated Landscape Buyback

Requires initial and post-removal site visits; turf replacement must comply with Community Development Landscaping Code (see separate program guidelines).

Removal of irrigated, established, non-native turf	\$2/sq. ft. (min 100 sq. ft., max 1,000 sq. ft.)
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The Fine Print About Rebates

Funding is limited and available on a first-come basis, so you are urged to secure your rebate before starting your project. Projects must meet program standards to qualify for rebates.
