- Garfield Clean Energy and all of the program utilities reserve the right to conduct an on-site inspection of the funded energy efficiency measures. The customer or member agrees to provide reasonable access to inspect the installation. On-site inspections may be performed up to one year after the installation date of the energy efficiency measures.
- Garfield Clean Energy and all of the program utilities are not responsible for the proper disposal/recycling of any waste generated as a result of this project; are not liable for any damage caused by the operation or malfunction of the installed equipment; and do not guarantee that a specific level of energy or cost savings will result from the implementation of energy efficiency measures or the use of products funded under these programs.
- Applicants will not be allowed to skip eligible energy efficiency measures that are deemed to be cost effective. Insulation, air sealing, and low-cost measures must be addressed before the replacement of mechanical equipment can be considered.
