WATER EFFICIENCY REBATES

Fixture Replacement Rebates

Rebates are for qualifying high-efficiency products (see separate program guidelines).

| High-efficiency hot water heater | \$100 |
| Insta-Hot hot water delivery system | \$100 |
| Sink faucet | \$35 (max 3 per year) |
| Showerhead | \$50 (max 2 per year) |
| Toilet | \$50 (max 2 per year) |

Irrigation Audit Rebates

Audit must be performed by a certified professional.

| Residential | \$75 (max 1 per 3 calendar years) |
| Commercial/multifamily/HOA/Irrigation | \$125 (max 1 per 3 calendar years) |

Sprinkler System Equipment Rebates

| Rain sensor | 50% up to \$15 (wired) or \$30 (wireless) |
| Soil moisture sensor | 50% up to \$45 |
| Controller | \$50 |
| Weather station add-on | 50% up to \$40 |
| Flow sensors | 50% up to \$100 |
| Spigot timers | 50% up to \$50 |
| Rotary nozzles | \$3 each (min 5 units, max 24 units) |
| Drip irrigation conversion equipment | 50% up to \$100 |

Irrigated Turf Buyback

Requires initial and post-removal site visits; turf replacement must comply with Community Development Landscaping Code (see separate program guidelines).
